THE DANISH EMBASSY IN TANZANIA IS LOOKING FOR THREE INTERNS FROM AUGUST 2018

The Danish Embassy in Dar es Salaam is responsible for the implementation of the Tanzania-Denmark Country Programme which includes support to the Health Sector, Good Governance and Private Sector as well as provision of Budget Support. In the 2018 fall semester, three interns will be recruited to work in the following areas: 1) Good Governance & Communication; 2) the Health Sector and finally, 3) Macroeconomic Analysis & Trade Council. The internship will challenge you in the sector specific area, help you apply your knowledge and skills and further develop your competencies. You will be given the opportunity to live in Dar es Salaam, guaranteeing experiences of African culture and a vibrant social life. Provided the internship can be accredited as part of your continued education, you will receive supervision and professional feedback for a possible mandatory assignment. However, this is not a requirement to apply for an internship. Below is a description of the internship for Good Governance & Communication.

GOOD GOVERNANCE AND COMMUNICATION

Do you wish to contribute to the Good Governance Programme in Tanzania? Do you have an interest in monitoring a political situation where power dynamics are changing? Are you motivated by effective communication of Danish development assistance to both a Danish and Tanzanian audience? If so, the position as Good Governance and Communication intern at the Embassy of Denmark in Dar es Salaam could be of interest to you.

You will take active part in the daily work at the Embassy, and you will be able to work with all sectors of the Embassy, thus obtaining solid insight into the policies and operations of the Danish Ministry of Foreign Affairs. Your primary tasks will be to:

Good Governance:

- Participate in the implementation of the Programme, supporting civil society, human rights, and gender
- Monitor, analyse and report on the current political and development situation in Tanzania
- Participate in dialogue with different partners incl. government, civil society organisations and other development partners

Communication:

- Supply Danish media with stories about Tanzania, the impact of Danish development assistance, business opportunities etc.
- Supply Tanzanian media with stories about Denmark, Danish development assistance and broader political issues of relevance to the Danish-Tanzanian relations
- Maintain the Embassy's social media platforms (Web, Facebook, Twitter) including producing news stories and assist with general communication and cultural assignments

Qualifications

- Be enrolled in a Danish University studying political science or similar fields (e.g. international relations, development studies, journalism, communication, law)
- Strong communications skills and good understanding of social media dynamics
- Knowledge of international development and good governance, incl. human rights, civil society and gender.
- Excellent English and Danish language skills (written and oral)
- Responsible, proactive, independent and dynamic with strong inter-personal skills

In the selection of the candidate, relevant professional and cultural experience from travelling or living abroad will be taken into consideration.

TERMS OF INTERNSHIP

Danish citizens must be enrolled at a Danish or foreign institution of higher education. Foreign citizens must have lived in Denmark for a period of 3-4 years, must be enrolled at a Danish institution of higher education and must live in Denmark at the time of the deadline of the application. All candidates should be able to speak, write and read both Danish and English.

The internships will begin from the 1st of August 2018 until 31st of January 2019. The three interns will live together. Depending where you are registered for your study, Danish State Education Grants (SU) may be received during the internship. The internship is unpaid but the Embassy will reimburse specified expenses related to the internship (e.g. airfare, vaccinations and insurance) and according to receipts submitted, within a total monthly ceiling of DKK 3,800. If you do not receive SU during the internship, the monthly supplement of DKK 3,800 can be paid without further documentation.
