THE DANISH EMBASSY IN TANZANIA IS LOOKING FOR THREE INTERNS FROM August 2018

The Danish Embassy in Dar es Salaam is responsible for the implementation of the Tanzania-Denmark Country Programme which includes support to the Health Sector, Good Governance and Private Sector as well as provision of Budget Support to the Tanzanian Government. In the 2018 fall semester, three interns will be recruited to work in the following areas: 1) Good Governance & Communication; 2) the Health Sector and 3) Macroeconomic Analysis & Trade Council. The internship will challenge you in the sector specific area, help you apply your knowledge and skills and further develop your competencies. You will be given the opportunity to live in Dar es Salaam, guaranteeing experiences of African culture and a vibrant social life. Provided the internship can be accredited as part of your continued education, you will receive supervision and professional feedback for a possible mandatory assignment. Below is a description of the internship for Macroeconomic Analysis & Trade Council.

MACROECONOMIC ANALYSIS & TRADE COUNCIL

Are you interested in working with international development in Africa and do you have a special interest in macroeconomics and Danish private sector involvement in Tanzania? Then an internship as a part of the Macroeconomic & Trade Council team may interest you. You will be a part of the Macroeconomic team with some affiliation to the Trade Council team.

Qualifications

You must at least have the following qualifications:

- Be enrolled in a Danish University studying economics or similar field (Bachelor or Masters)
- Good analytical skills
- Interest in and preferable experience with international development issues
- Strong language skills in oral and written English and Danish
- Good communication and interpersonal skills
- Ability to work in a team is essential

Areas of work

As an intern you will take part in the daily work at the Embassy and the Macroeconomic & Trade Council team in particular. Your primary tasks will be:

- Contribute to and prepare economic and sector analytical papers, including macro analytical work in relation to the implementation of the Danish development assistance to Tanzania;
- Retain a close contact with national research institutes and key civil society partners engaged in socio-economic research;
- Provide analytical work and support in relation to Trade Council affairs;
- Monitoring of key economic indicators.

TERMS OF INTERNSHIP

Danish citizens must be enrolled at a Danish or foreign institution of higher education. Foreign citizens must have lived in Denmark for a period of 3-4 years, must be enrolled at a Danish institution of higher education and must live in Denmark at the time of the deadline of the application. All candidates should be able to speak, write and read both Danish and English.

The internships will begin 14 August 2018 and last until 31 January 2019. The three interns are expected to live together. Depending where you are registered for your study, Danish State Education Grants (SU) may be received during the internship. The internship is unpaid but the Embassy will reimburse specified expenses related to the internship (e.g. airfare, vaccinations and insurance) and according to receipts submitted, within a total monthly ceiling of DKK 3,800. If you do not receive SU during the internship, the monthly supplement of DKK 3,800 can be paid without further documentation.
